## Archdiocese of Newark Anniversary Liturgies for 2020



Celebrating Service

Catholic Schools Week kicked off our celebration of the Academy's 70<sup>th</sup> Anniversary. Throughout the year, the Academy will recognize our Anniversary in various ways, but one of the most important is the '70 Acts of Service'. Catholic Schools Week provided us the opportunity to start on some of these projects.

The 5th, 7th and 8th grades created jars of "uplifting messages" which will be given to those in need of hope and joy. Fifth grade also worked with their Pre-K 4 buddies and created Valentine's Day cards for the residents at McCauley Hall. The 8th grade writing class wrote letters to seminarians supporting their mission of serving God as a Catholic priest.

Third Grade created 'Color a Smile' pictures that will be sent to the elderly. The students performed a random act of kindness for someone they didn't know by giving a small note with either a candy or a tea bag. Even our youngest students are learning the value of service. Students in PreK-3 and PreK-4 made placemats and a craft for the February St. Bartholomew Parish senior luncheon.

The students were challenged to perform one act of kindness each day and record it on a slip of paper. The SAVE club and Student Council collected the slips and connected them together creating a colorful chain that is hanging along the second-floor hallway. The entire school participated in creating a prayer wall. Students learned that prayer is also an act of service. As they prayed this week, they were invited to share those prayers. The chains and the prayer wall remind students to continue their dedication to service, and that even the smallest act can have a great impact.
