

First Holy Communion

Virtual Jesus Day: Sat., Sept. 12th (9:30 - 11:00am)

If we had been able to meet in person, we would have gathered for an onsite Jesus Day which is a retreat program for First Communion children and their parents. It is usually a lovely morning filled with fun, prayer and learning. While Virtual Jesus Day will be a modified program conducted via Zoom, I believe it will capture many of the elements of a regular Jesus Day. I do encourage all families to participate, even those who have decided to wait until next spring for First Communion. The learning and preparation that will take place will support your child well regardless of when he or she is receiving First Communion.

<u>Picking Up Materials for Virtual Jesus Day:</u> Week of Sept. 2 - 11

There will be a packet of materials prepared for each family to use at Virtual Jesus Day. Please pick up your child's packet in the church building at the side door when you first enter the church property. The church door is open from 7am until 12noon. There is a chance these packets will be ready prior to Sept. 8th; if so, Janet Manfredonia will contact everyone to let them know. If you will have difficulty stopping by to pick up your child's packet, please ask a friend to help you, or please let us know and we will try to make other arrangements with you.

First Communion Banners

Back in March just prior to the pandemic restrictions, you may recall that we mailed home the First Communion workbooks and other materials. In that mailing there was a banner kit (from Oriental Trading). Please help your child assemble his/her banner prior to Virtual Jesus Day on Sept. 12th, and try to have it available that morning. If you cannot find your banner kit, please let me or Janet know and we can include an additional kit for you in the Jesus Day packet you will pick up during the week of Sept. 8th.

First Communion Kahoot!

At our Virtual Jesus Day on Sat., Sept. 12th, we will have a First Communion Kahoot game which will help review the topics contained in the First Communion workbooks (God's Gift: Eucharist). You may find it helpful for your child to take a look at the workbook and the review guide that was in the March mailing. I have attached a duplicate copy of the review guide for your convenience.

Confirmation Dates

We are happy to announce that we have dates for Confirmation Masses and preliminary plans. We are still dealing with restrictions due to the coronavirus, and these restrictions will come into play at the Confirmation Masses. As we continue to respond to the pandemic, even these plans I share with you today could change in upcoming weeks. In any event, we move forward in peace and confidence and hope in the Lord!

Due to the pandemic circumstances, Cardinal Tobin has given the authority to all pastors to confirm the young people in their parishes. Therefore, Father Mike will be the presider for the Sacrament of Confirmation at IHM this year at each of the Masses shown below.

Dates/times of Confirmation Masses: (use the Sign-Up Link that was sent to you via email to choose a Confirmation Mass)

Sat., Oct. 10th @ 9:30am and 11:30am Sun., Oct., 11th @ 10am Sat., Oct. 17th @ 9:30am and 11:30am Sun., Oct. 18th @ 10am

Virtual Zoom Practices:

Fri., Oct. 9th @ 6:30 - 7:30pm Fri., Oct. 16th @ 6:30 - 7:30pm

Basic Guidelines for Confirmation Masses:

- Saturday Confirmation Masses will have a limit of 10 candidates per Mass.
- Sunday Confirmation Masses will have a limit of 5 candidates per Mass.
- Each Mass will have a limit of 5 family members from the same household including the Confirmation Candidate and Sponsor. It is highly recommended that a parent stand in as a proxy for the Sponsor if the Sponsor is not a member of the Candidate's household. (Note: family members who have traveled out of New Jersey to a travel advisory state should meet the 14 day self quarantine requirement prior to attending the Confirmation Mass; sponsors who would be traveling to NJ from a travel advisory state need to meet the 14 day quarantine requirement as well, prior to the date of Confirmation.)
- All Masses will be livestreamed and recorded. All Covid-19 protocols will be followed including wearing of face masks and social distancing.

We understand some families may not feel comfortable returning to a public space in October, even for Confirmation. If you prefer your child wait to receive Confirmation, you may choose to wait until next Easter season when he/she can be confirmed with the next group of Confirmation Candidates. Please let us know if you prefer this. Contact Mary Clinton or Janet Manfredonia with any questions.
