Yet in his arrogance David has forgotten who is in charge, he has forgotten who has put him in the position he is in, rich and powerful, able to rest from his labors and unthreatened by his enemies. God reminds him of all that He has done for David, and that He is not finished.

For, as Gabriel says to Mary, “Nothing will be impossible for God.” The stories of David and Mary remind us, as we make our final preparations to celebrate the birth of our Savior, to place our trust completely in God, even when it seems impossible. They remind us to approach God with humility, reverence and awe for all that he has done and continues to do for us.

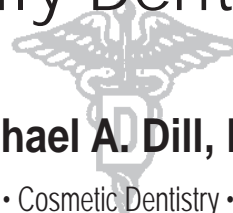
