A Message from Faith Formation Pastoral Associate: John McGuire

Out of Order Gifts of the Holy Spirit: Pt. 1 Fear of the Lord If you are really advanced in your faith formation, or remember my reflection from last week, you might know that the gifts of the Holy Spirit are Wisdom, Understanding, Counsel, Foritude, Knowledge, Piety, and Fear of the Lord. Each year I meet with the families of 8th graders beginning their process of preparing for Confirmation, and I've asked the parents if they could name

these gifts (because it would take the pressure off of me to remember them). I have a hard time remembering them all, many parents do, and most people who haven't been in faith formation since they were in 7th grade struggle with them as well. No wonder people so easily look at Confirmation as a graduation. If we don't frequently cultivate and intentionally use these gifts out in the world, how can we expect the young people to rise up and do better than us? We're going to do this out of order. This week we'll focus on Fear of the Lord, because it strikes us the most odd. It stands out on the list (especially if you know what Piety is). Otherwise known as Awe of the Lord, this gift is the farthest from what you experience at a horror movie. No, what we are talking about is like when Mary was approached by the Angel Gabriel. She was in awe of the magnificence of God's Messenger. An experience of God with any of our senses is life changing.

Fear of the Lord is the ability to distinguish what is magnificent from what is mundane. You may be able to appreciate the artistic design of a billboard on the side of the road. However, that won't be life changing or earth shaking. Yet when you go to a famous gallery to witness a masterpiece like the Mona Lisa, Starry Night, or the statue of David, these stand apart from the everyday. Fear of the Lord is being able to distinguish creator from creation, and paying proper reverence. This week, let's pray that the young people preparing for Confirmation might be fully prepared to receive this gift, and that all of us who already have received the sacrament might also fully embrace the Fear of the Lord. 




