




### A NOTE FROM FATHER MIKE

We often think of our relationship with Jesus as a personal and individual relationship. While there is a personal aspect to it, today's Gospel shows us that it is first a communal relationship, us and Jesus. Peter's profession of faith is made and the power of the keys is given not only to Peter (today's passage), but also to the community (see Matthew 18:18). Thus it is important to remember that our faith is a gift to all of us, not just individuals, and that Jesus has charged Peter, in union with the disciples, to protect and hand down this faith to future generations (through the Pope and bishops). It is this relationship with Jesus, the Christ, the son of the Living God, that for us as individuals and as a community of faith, nourishes us to fulfill the will of God in our lives and build up his kingdom. This relationship that brings us hope, joy and peace each day, and supports us in sharing that hope, joy and peace, with the people we encounter, stranger and friend, in our daily lives.


