### A Message from Faith Formation Pastoral Associate: John McGuire

What are the ways that we can prepare ourselves to reach the source and summit of our faith? How can we properly approach the mystery of the Eucharist, in its fullest expression, the communal celebration of the Mass?

Those who are preparing their hearts and minds to receive Jesus, have to first come to terms with their flaws, sins, and how they have fallen short. Because First Reconciliation usually takes place in 2nd grade, we make the mistake of thinking that it is a childish thing.

However, it is not until we are older, wiser, and more worldly that we can truly begin to grasp the momentous grace available to us, when we approach Jesus in the Sacrament of Reconciliation. This week, our young people are meeting to ramp up their training to climb the mountain of our Lord. Their basecamp will be preparation for Reconciliation.

Pray for our parents, that they may find the beauty and relevance of this sacrament while accompanying their children, and that the children of our parish may more fully experience the love of our Lord, and His forgiveness.
