#### A NOTE FROM FATHER MIKE

The road to Christ's Kingship was through the cross. It is a road of sacrifice and suffering, not of comfort and wealth. Our Gospel today makes this clear. It is a reminder to each of us that to fulfill our baptismal call to participate in the mission of Christ means that we must also die to ourselves so the we can rise to new life in the service of God and neighbor, and so enter into the Glory of God's Kingdom. The two criminals crucified with Jesus are, in a sense, invited into a relationship with Jesus, into the reality of the cross. One denies that invitation, thinking only of himself, that Jesus could save his life. The other takes up the invitation by seeking a closer and more profound relationship with Christ in His kingdom. We are always given the same invitation. Do we choose the closer more profound and saving relationship with Christ or do we think only of what he can do for us at the moment?

#### Archdiocese of Newark - COVID-19 Directives - Updated May 15, 2022

STILL IN EFFECT: Masks will no longer be required for fully vaccinated persons. If not fully vaccinated, persons are strongly encouraged to follow CDC guidance and wear a face mask in public settings. People will no longer be required to socially distance indoors or outdoors, although unvaccinated persons should continue to maintain a safe distance from others. These directives apply to Masses and activities in Church. Archdiocesan protocols for Religious Education and Basketball programs remain in effect.

**LITURGICAL MINISTERS:** All ministries may return to full service – altar servers, lectors, ushers, greeters and extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion. Ministers of Holy Communion must still sanitize their hands and wear a mask when distributing Communion.

**COMMUNION:** While Communion on the tongue is now permitted, for the safety of the priests, ministers and other communicants, we encourage continued reception of communion in the hand. At this time, Communion from the cup should not be distributed to the assembly.

**SANITIZING:** The cleaning and sanitizing of churches and common spaces is done regularly. It is not required after every liturgy.

**PARISH MEETINGS:** Parish meetings in person may resume. Those vaccinated are not required to wear masks for indoor meetings nor are they required to maintain social distancing. The same recommendations for Mass apply to those not vaccinated.





Previously we have reported our weekly collection "need" to reflect what we submitted in our budget to the Archdiocese. However, this number does not give us a balanced budget. So moving forward, we revised our target to balance our budget:

This increase in need (from \$11,200 to \$12,558) would balance our budget. However, our true "stretch" target, where we would balance PLUS pay back our debt to the Archdiocese in 3 years (for healthcare, insurance, assessment) would be \$14,274. In this scenario, the deficit for last week's collection is \$6,210.45, and fiscal year to date is \$65,077.93.

A Message from John McGuire: On the fourth Thursday of every November we celebrate a national feast called Thanksgiving. What is served at that feast is determined by each family, and their personal traditions. However, one thing is generally held in common, that we all give thanks for our blessings. The idea of sharing a meal and giving thanks is by no means an invention of the New World. During the Passover Seder, Jewish people take part in the thousands of years old meal giving thanks for God's saving actions to free their people from Israel. I won't go too deep into the details, but at this meal the people gather together, share a meal, and give thanks for God's saving actions. What is unique to this practice is they do not simply remember the first Passover, they participate in it. It might be surprising to consider this, but the Last Supper would have been a Seder meal. Jesus with His followers shared a meal, and gave thanks. As they shared the meal together, they would have an understanding that they were taking part in the original Passover meal. So when Jesus said to continue this meal in His memory, the people He was addressing would draw the connection to the Passover meal. So whenever we gather for Mass for a weekday, Sunday, or Holy Day of Obligation, we are sharing a meal, giving thanks, and participating in the same sacrifice that Jesus had shared with His Disciples. Every Eucharist is a meal and offering of thanks, that truly connects us with Jesus in the same way that He did with His early followers. So while we can enjoy the celebration of Thanksgiving with our family, and should, we acknowledge that our greatest giving thanks or Eucharist takes place in Church, and is shared with our even larger family, the Church that first gathered for the Eucharist at the Last Supper and continues to do so today. This week, as we prepare to celebrate with our families, let us give thanks for the great sacrament of the Altar the Eucharist.
