A NOTE FROM FATHER MIKE

In listening to Mark's description of John the Baptist in today's Gospel, his community would have called to mind the prophet Elijah (John's clothing and food are similar) whose coming heralded the coming of the Messiah, the exodus, the exile, and the return of the people of Israel to the promised land. He is indicating that Jesus will be the one who is to come, the messiah, the Christ. He also helps them, and us, to understand what we must do in order to prepare for this great event. We must make straight the way, remove the mountains and valleys that are obstacle to the Lord's coming into our lives.

One sure way to do this is by recognizing our own sinfulness, seeking God's mercy and then allowing that mercy to transform us as the people did with John the Baptist. We are better able to rejoice with awe at the coming of our Lord rather than fear and trembling. 



A Message from Faith Formation Pastoral Associate: John McGuire

Who are you spending more time preparing for this Advent, for the coming of Christ our Lord or Santa Claus? I think this second week of Advent, that is the most important question to ask. Making way for either of these people takes a certain level of devotion, and preparation. While there is some overlap, There are distinct differences. Preparing to welcome Santa Claus is somewhat external. Trim the tree, set the table, bake the cookies, and shop, shop, shop for the gifts. Parents harry themselves, and children are called to behave, lest they receive coal for the fireplace. The modern concept of Santa is applied to instill a sense of wonder, but also compliance. Listen to your parents, teachers, and authorities, or there won't be gifts (though Santa almost always seems to come through;) Preparing for the coming of Jesus requires much more. Our Lord requires transformation over compliance. We are called to change our hearts to love, and not just those who are easy to love. Rend your hearts for those who already break them. Prepare your hearts, not just your homes. Care for those who are hungry, thirsty, imprisoned, and sick. Then you are ready for Jesus. So, even as we prepare for Santa, let's spend some extra time in prayer and action, to ready our hearts for the coming of our Savior Jesus Christ, both in His birth celebrated at Christmas, but also as He comes again!




