1 Samuel 1:24-28 1Samuel 2:1, 4-5, 6-7, 8 Luke 1:46-56

I read of 2 women who have opened their hearts fully to the Lord. Hanna asks the Lord for a child and He grants her request. Hanna accepts the gift with love and unfailing faith. To thank God she dedicates Samuel to him and leaves him at the temple. Hannah is not afraid and remains dedicated and open in her faith to God.

Mary does not ask for a child but is granted a most hold gift by the Lord because of her openness and faithfulness to the Lord. Mary although fearful at first, accepts the Word spoken to her with utter openness. Her fear dissolves and Mary offers herself as God's servant, unafraid to bear forth the child Jesus. Mary praises God for his holiness and greatness. She sees that God rewards those who see only good things, who show mercy, who show compassion and kindness, who love.

Both women's faith helped to prepare them for accepting God's word and actions. Faith has also prepared them for what is to come later in life. Hannah for dedicating Samuel to the Lord and Mary to know of the physical loss of her child. Both women returned to God what had been given to them. The Lord will reward those with open hearts and acceptance of faith, those who will think of others first in love and compassion. He is there for those who may be failing and will give them strength as they turn to him. Preparing ourselves to accept God, in all that is happening in the world today can be difficult task...

But, praying and asking God for help, preparing your heart for acceptance will ease fear, settle confusing thoughts, clear hearts and minds from the cloudiness of indecision. His love will give strength.

As Advent comes to a close can you reflect on your openness for accepting God in your life? Prepare for submitting to God for what he asks of us? Prepare for his love and gifts he will give to you if you ask? Let us not be afraid to be open to the Lord. Open your heart to the Lord in preparation of this Christmas Joy.
